Important Notice

The Association is receiving information at various levels of persons using tobacco products within the technical area. I will remind all of the following that was issued by FNSW in August 2004:

Players are banned from smoking in any game they are participating in; and

Smoking is banned by team staff, officials, players, referees and volunteers in technical areas, access way to and from the field of play, canteen servery and preparation areas, dressing rooms, change rooms and medical rooms.

In addition to this there are also local council guidelines which much be adhered to on various grounds.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY – REFEREE'S WILL BE INSTRUCTED TO REMOVE ANY OFFENDER OF THE ABOVE FROM THE TECHNICAL AREA. SHOULD A TEAM OFFICIAL BE REMOVED FROM THE TECHNICAL AREA THEY ARE TO HAVE THEIR ID CARD TAKEN BY THE REFEREE AND WILL INCUR THE MADATORY 1-MATCH SUSPENSION BY THE ASSOCIATION AS A MINIMUM PENALTY. ADDITIONAL SANCTIONS/PENALTIES MAY BE IMPOSED. Any team official found to be in the technical area while under suspension will be stood down until further notice and the Club may be fined up to \$250.00.

Correct ID Cards

We draw your attention to Rule 5.2.10, in particular the following:

“... Where a player is eligible and wishes to play for a higher team under this Rule, the player must apply for and obtain his/her new ID card prior to taking the field in that finals match.”

This section was added to the Rules after last season. Any person that plays in any final MUST have an ID card for that team. Remember you can only play in one finals division.

Should a Club require a new ID card to be produced for a particular player:

Notification MUST be received by the Association by 7pm Wednesday prior to the game.

The old card must be RETURNED in place of any new card being issued

A player that presents an ID card stating other than the age/division of the finals game they are about to play in will not be permitted to play. Should this player still play and is later found out to have played said player will be deemed ineligible and the game will be forfeited by the offending team. Whilst referees check cards prior to the game ultimately it is the CLUBS/TEAMS RESPONSIBILITY to ensure their players are playing in accordance with the rules of this competition.

Coach Talk

Drill of the Week

Soccer coaching tips for controlling the ball

Good players are comfortable on the ball - use the following soccer coaching tips to get your young players' ball control skills up to speed.

How often does it happen that you get a breakaway where the ball gets passed to one of your midfielders, who only has to turn and run to set himself up with a glorious goal-scoring chance... but, no, he miscontrols it, kicks it too far in front of him and what should have been a good move by your team comes to nothing.

Some players can do it naturally - others need a lot of coaching and endless training drills. One thing's for sure, plenty of soccer drills focusing on ball control are vital to your training nights.

How to coach good ball control skills

Banish any thoughts you may have that players can only use one part of their body to control the ball - check out any professional game and you will see someone in an awkward shape end up seconds later with the ball at their feet under control. Rarely during a game will the ball come at the perfect speed, height or direction so you cushion it with your feet.

So what can you control the ball with?

Inside of the foot

Plant the supporting foot 45-90 degrees to the path of the ball. Control the ball with the arch of the free foot.

Outside of the foot

Used when the ball is travelling across in front of the player. Just reach forward into the ball's path.

Sole of the foot

Raise the toes slightly above the heel. Used in dribbling for stopping before changing direction.

Instep

For when the ball's falling from a steep angle. Stretch the ankle and cushion with the 'laces' by bending the knee and ankle on contact.

Thigh

Aim for about halfway up the top of the thigh, although the inside is good for stopping balls flying past.

Chest

May involve arching the back slightly, bending the knees and even jumping.

Head

Use the forehead, just below the hairline.

One of the soccer skills to teach your players is that using any parts of their body, they will usually have to use cushion control - taking the sting out of the ball by pulling back the controlling surface on impact. This cushions the pace of the ball so it drops to their feet.

The other way to control the ball is to wedge it between their foot and the ground - this is used when a player wants to force the ball downwards or into space to move onto it.

You've got to try out these ball control skills and drills yourself - wedging isn't easy to do, let alone coach!

Coaching Philosophies

Children are great imitators. Therefore, you are more likely to shape them into your own image than into what you would actually like them to become.

The coach is a very powerful role model. This is why it is important that the coach be honest as he/she evaluates her/himself and get in touch with here/his own feelings. The coach needs to discover whether he really likes who he/she is. A quick subjective self-awareness test would be to ask oneself "When I was a child, would I have liked to have my current self as a parent? As a coach? If the answer is "yes," explain to yourself why do you think the way you do. What is it that makes you a good parent, teacher, coach?

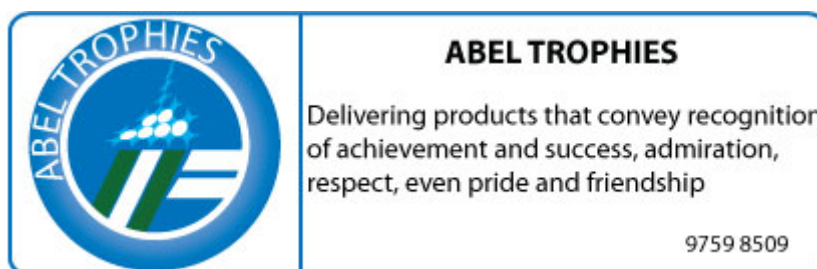
